III. Review Policy for a Third Reading.

Mr. Grippo reviewed revisions to Policy #5141 Student Health Services in regard to Health Assessments for students. Any student participating in an interscholastic sports program must have a health assessment. Their physical examination must be valid for 13 months and cover the athlete for the entire sport season (including the tryout period). Physicals cannot expire during the season. This is to prevent a medical risk to the student and also legal liability for the district. Mr. Grippo noted that there have been no changes since the first reading.

MOTION by Ms. Hallen and seconded by Mr. Grippo.

MOVED to bring Policy #5141 to the full Board for a third reading and approval.

VOTE: The Motion passed unanimously 2-0.
